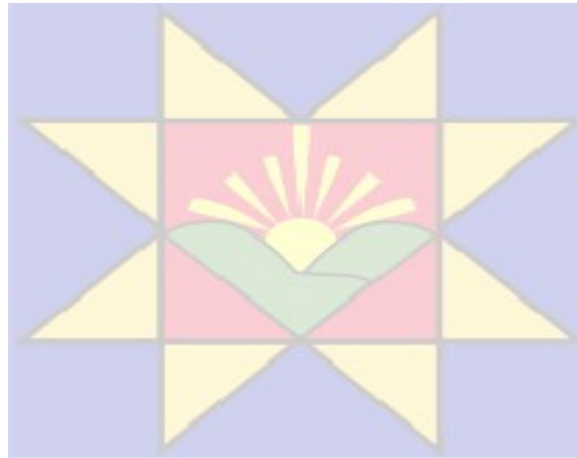

Dear Quilting Friends,

This year has had its challenges! We are all looking forward to some cooler weather and clearer skies. We are anticipating some more regulations in place so that we can keep everyone safe. **We at Pleasant Valley Quilting are expecting everyone that is either shopping or taking classes to be fully vaccinated, and to wear mask.** We appreciate that we have a very ideal classroom with lots of spacing between tables so we can still offer classes and sewing days to get back to what we love best, quilting.

We have been very successful with our classes, using and implementing all the guidelines during this difficult time. We are trying not to have classes that require up close instruction, in keeping with the social distancing rules. There is limited space in the classes, no more than 9 students, so please sign up as soon as possible.

The tables in our classroom are set up so you have everything you need at your own table. **We ask you to wear a mask to enter the store or classroom. When attending a class and sitting at your table with a minimum of 6 feet apart, you may take off your mask, or you are eating or drinking at your table.** This is the current CDC regulations, and we will adjust our policies as things improve, and as restrictions are lifted. ***If you forget to put your mask on while you are walking around the room, you will be gently reminded, but please do not take this personal, its easy to forget. Thank you for your co operation.***

When taking a class, please park in the back parking lot, behind the building and use the rear door of the classroom to enter and leave. **We will continue take every precaution for you, to provide a safe environment to shop and take classes at our store.**

If there are any groups out there that meet on a regular basis and would like to schedule dates, to rent our fabulous class room, please give us a call. The maximum is 9 people.

There is additional dates for Sewing days in the class schedule, For the months of September to December, On Mondays and Tuesdays, \$15 a day. We ask you to book for the day of the week that works for you and attend all of them in a given month. If you would like to attend both Monday & Tuesday the class fee would be \$25 dollars for both days per week.

YOU MUST PREREGISTER for all classes, clubs and Sewing Days prior to attendance.

LET'S GET STARTED 1 TABLE RUNNER

Instructor: Carol Cooney

In the beginning there were tools, techniques and a new language for all new Quilters to master. Learn the basics of fabrics, cutting, sewing, piecing, safety and the care of your equipment. This series of classes covers the basics required in taking your first step along with finishing touches to complete the project.

BEGINNER FOUNDATION PAPER PIECED ~ TABLE RUNNER

This class is intended as a technique class for those who already have basic knowledge and experience with quilt making. We will provide a kit to make a practice block to learn the steps. Then we will move on to to make a table runner using the same technique. This class will encourage you to take on bigger projects using this accurate and unique technique. **Prerequisite:** Let's Get Started 1 or equivalent.

BEGINNER APPLIQUE TABLE RUNNER

Students will make practice samples of three different applique techniques - Turned under edges with templates, faced applique and fused applique. A small kit is included in class fee for the samples. After the samples of applique, then you can choose the techniques that you would like to use in your table runner. You will learn to adapt patterns to use your preferred methods of applique.

Back by popular request and complete with a simpler version! Take the one block wonder technique and turn it up a notch by using 7 panels or fabric repeats. Sew a bit, play alot, then sew some more! If you wish to use yardage rather than a panel you are more than welcome to take the class as it is a technique plus additional teaching. You can also try taking 5 panels or repeats and do the same without the hassle of bias triangles. There is time set between the two dates of the class, so that you have lots of time to finish the blocks and design a layout that works for you. **Class fee: \$95**

The large bag has two pockets on the outside and pockets on the inside also. The cost of the class does not include the patterns. Each size bag has its own pattern, that comes with "Stays" included.
